Software Re-installation

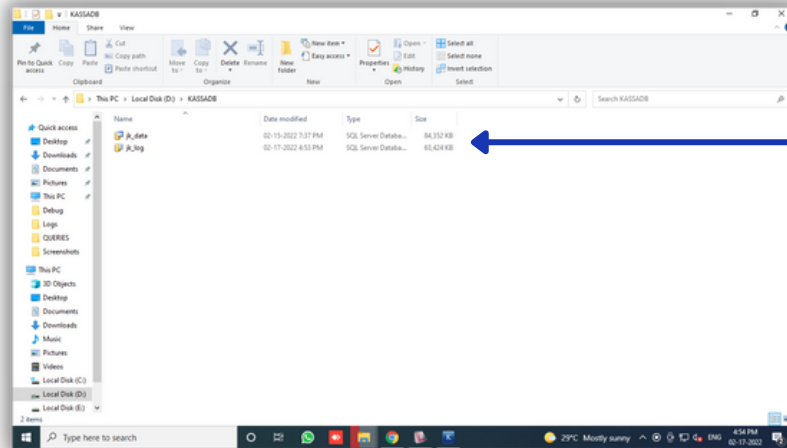
Step 1: Set up the following applications first.

- 1. Crystal Report**
- 2. Dot Net Framework**
- 3. Font**
- 4. Linqpad**
- 5. Notepad++**
- 6. SQL Backward Compatability**
- 7. SQL Engine**

Now restore the empty database and find the database which has already been restored.

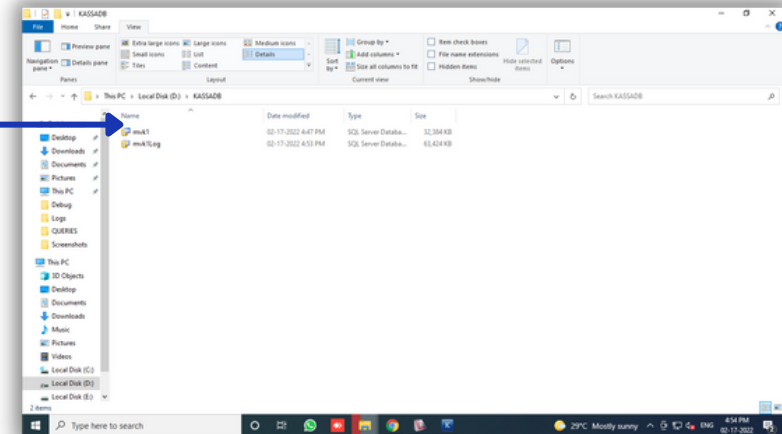

Step 2: Find The Restored Old Database



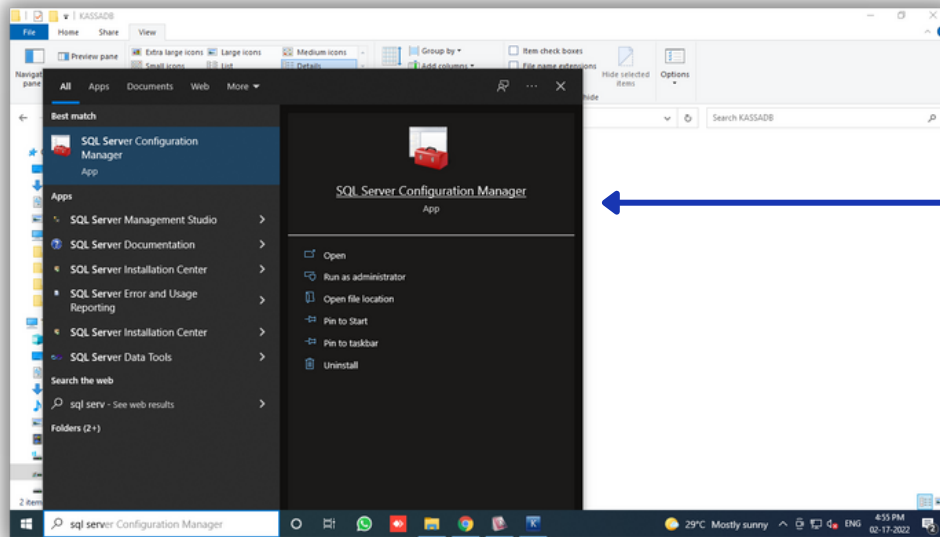
Search the previous database from the date and time usage And Note Down The Location

Go to the New Database Location



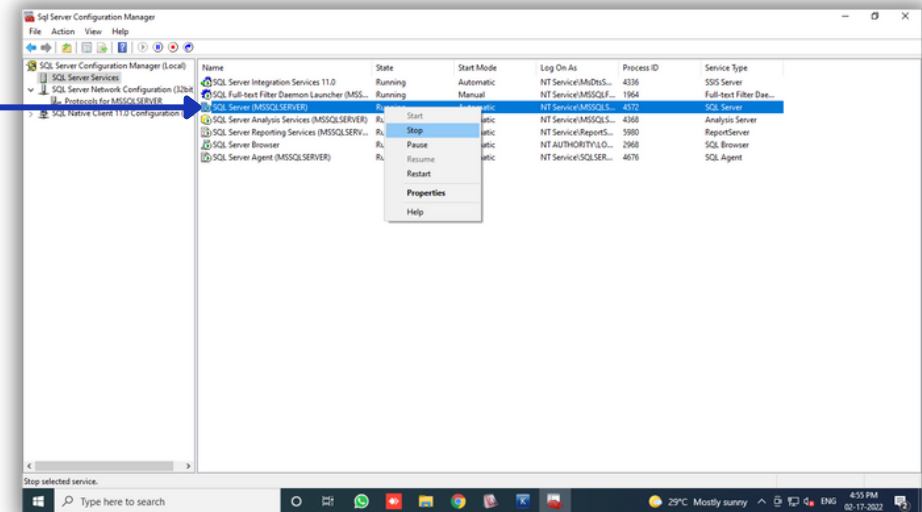

Step 3: Stop and start the SQL server as described below.

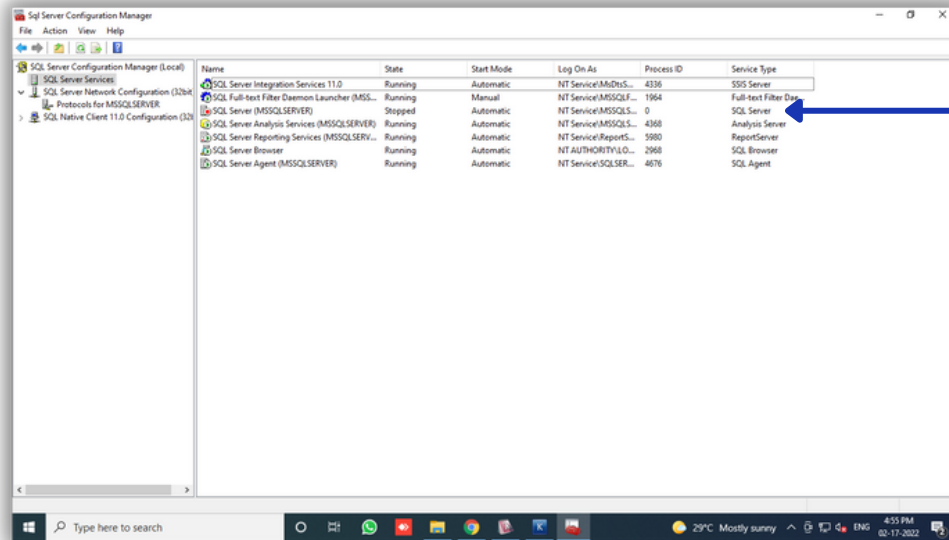


Open SQL Server (Windows Key->Type Sql Server-> click Open

Right Click On "SQL server" and Click on Stop

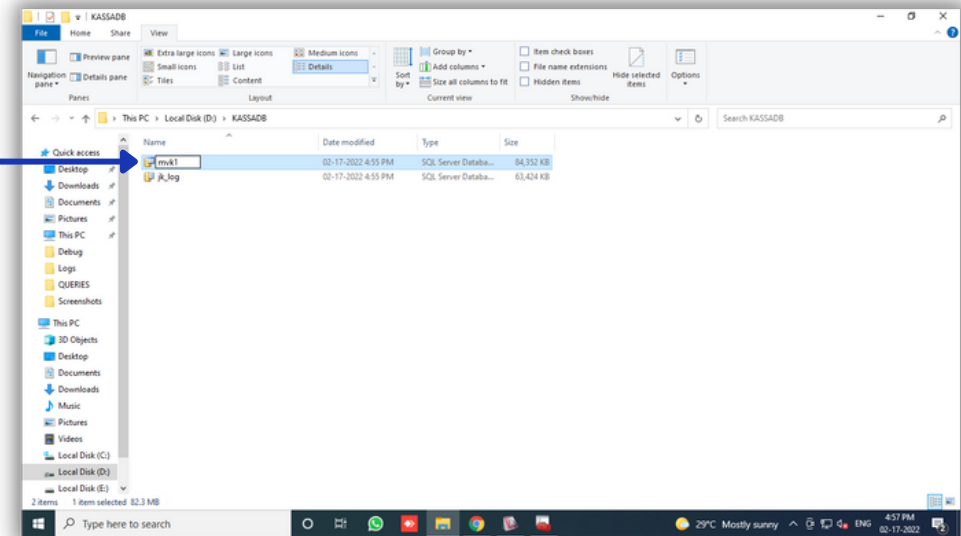

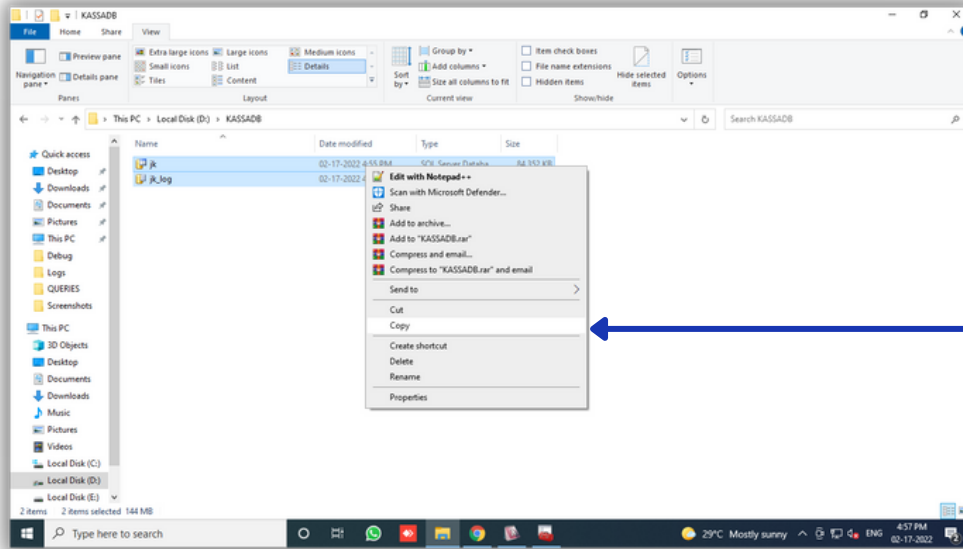


Check if SQL Server is Stopped Or Not

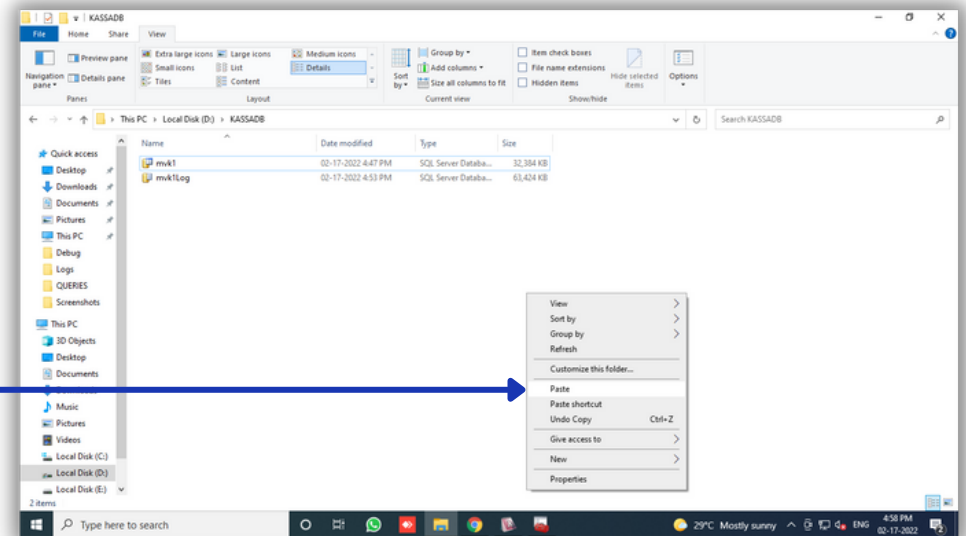
Rename the Old Database Name with recently installed Database Name.



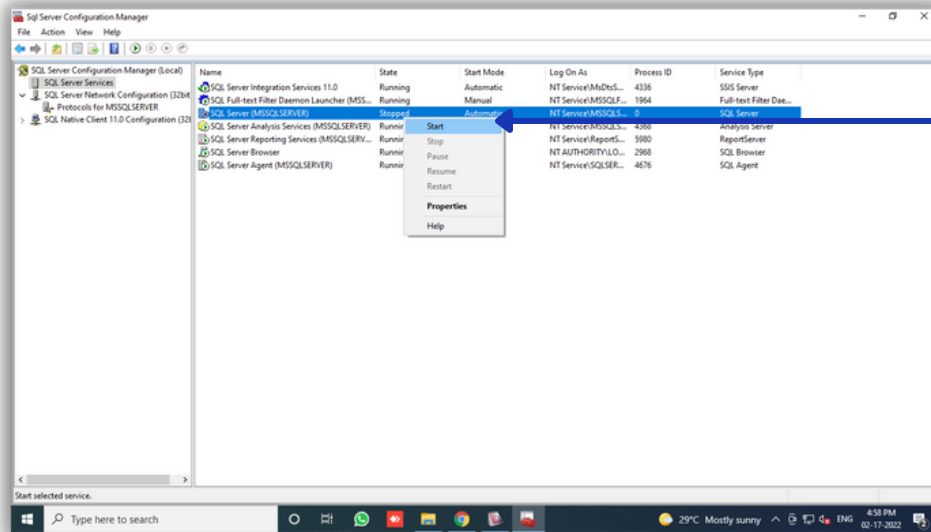
